OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Upon receiving Jack, open release valve and pump handle several times. This will eliminate any airbound condition that may have occurred during shipment.
2. To raise Jack, close release valve and operate pump handle.
3. To lower, open release valve.

FAILURE TO OPERATE

1. Release may not be completely closed.
2. Airbound - See Instruction No.1.
3. Foreign matter in valve line - Repeat Instruction No.1.
4. Too much oil - Lower to filler screw level.
5. Interior parts may be worn allowing oil to by-pass. Contact nearest Franchised Service Depot.

FAILURE TO LIFT LOAD

1. Airbound pump - Operating Instructions No.1.
2. By-pass at valve balls - Operating Instructions No.1. Reseat valve balls using small brass rod and hammer.
3. Foreign matter on release seat - Operating Instructions No.1.
4. Lack of oil - With lifting arm down, fill to filler plug level.
5. Overload set too low - Contact nearest Franchised Service Depot from list on back page.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

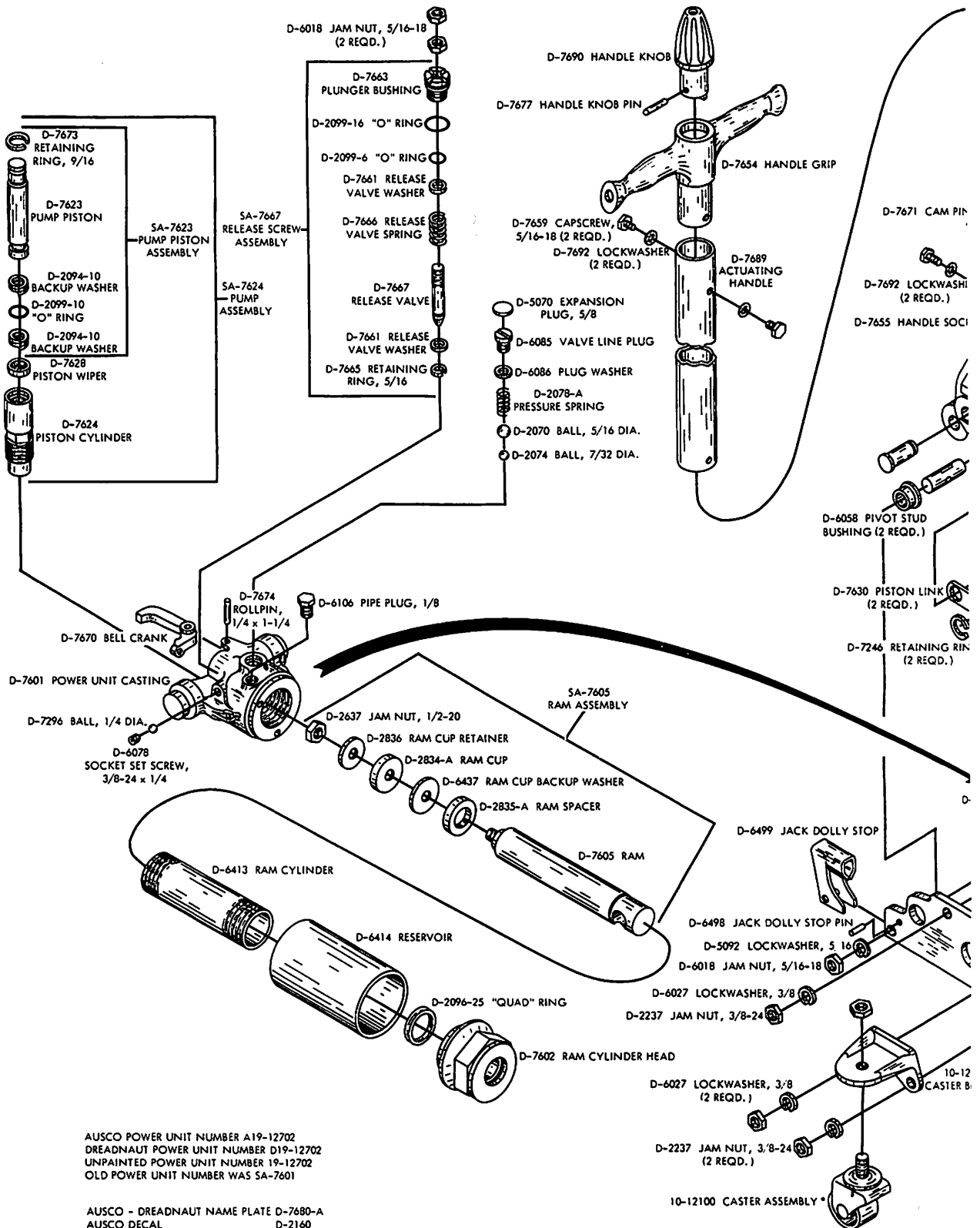
1. Keep all moving parts well lubricated to prevent rust and excessive wear.
2. Repair Kit Number 5-551.

Always use garage stands to support vehicle before making under-vehicle repairs.

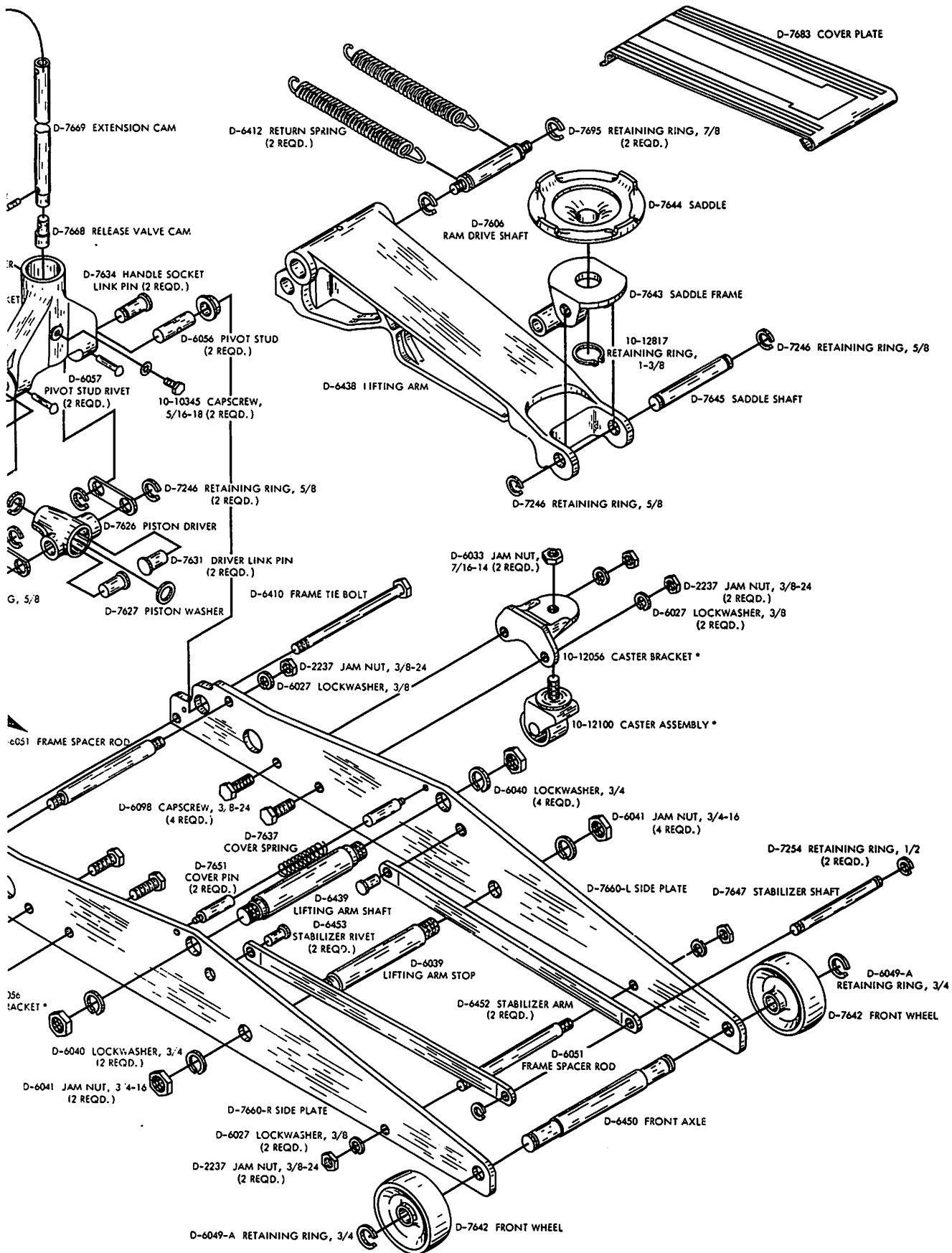
